- 3) Maintenance of an acceptable grade point average. Undergraduates must have a minimum 2.5 GPA; graduates must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. Please submit an official copy of your transcript with this form.

Basis of Award:

After establishment of eligibility, a committee of the Board will review all applicants and make awards based upon their determination of students' need and likely contribution to the Capital Region community.

Award:

Fall and Spring – two \$1,000 scholarships each semester awarded upon successful completion of the course.

Summer – one \$1,000 scholarship awarded upon successful completion of the course.
